- Shared measurement and accountability metrics
- Integration and adoption of equity, diversity, and inclusion principles

**Portfolio of Interventions**

Based on the shared vision and common agenda, with equity as a core principle

**Implementation of Interventions**

- Feedback loop between all stakeholders
- Continuous learning ensuring equity
- May be related to policy, systems, or environmental change

**Investment in Technology**

- Across systems: health, social services, others
- Interoperable

**Actionable Data**

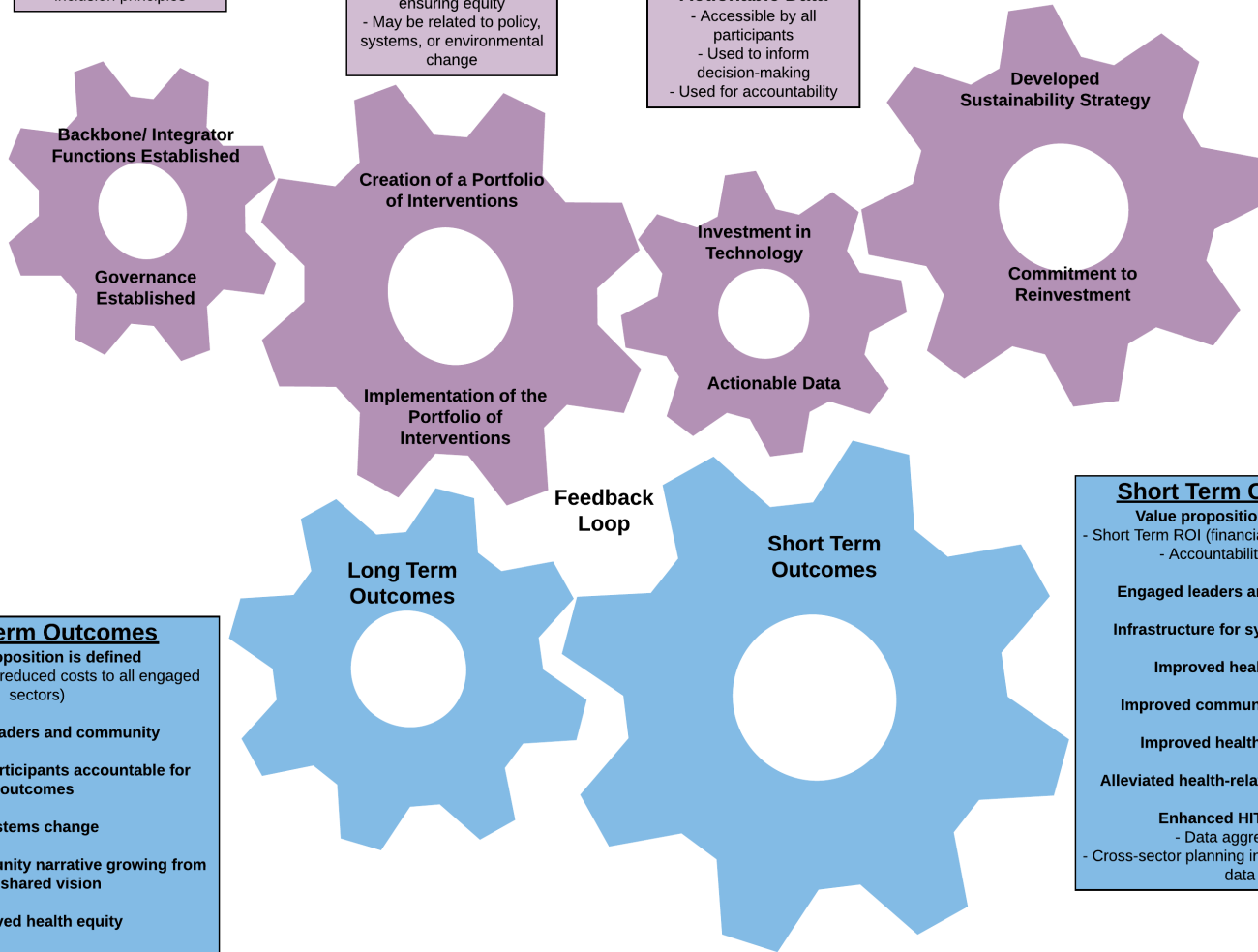
- Accessible by all participants

**Sustainability Strategy**

- Value case is reaffirmed or redeveloped
